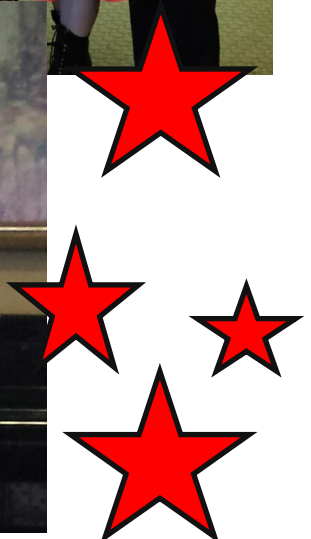


Jeanne & Jim Martin
